Little/Toy Dog Tips



If you don't want your adorable little dog to morph into an armpit piranha, don't neglect training and follow these simple tips. Your toy will transform from a teeth-first tyrant to a pretty little pacifist in no time:

Walk the Walk: Let your toy dog walk on the ground. Don't carry her everywhere, just be sure to keep a close eye on him/her.

Talk the Talk: Enforce house rules. Don't let your toy dog do something even once if you don't want it to become a habit.

Last 'til the Last: Don't reinforce bad behavior. Biting, snarling, snapping and hyperactive yapping aren't cute behaviors. Tell him/her “No!” Only give cuddles for good behaviors.
